Championship Rules and Regulations

A. Definitions

1. In this agreement:

- (i) **The Organiser** refers to the Ballroom Dance Academy (Singapore) Pte. Ltd.;
- (ii) **Championship** refers to the Singapore Dance Championship 2020 and all associated events;
- (iii) **Judge** refers to any authority appointed by The Organiser to invigilate any relevant event in the Championship;
- (iv) **Competitor(s)** refers to any participant registered for any event in the Championship; and
- (v) **Media** refers to any form of information data pertaining to the Championship. It includes, but is not limited to, audio-visual livestreams or recordings, photographs, or any documents (such as the results of various events within the Championship).

B. General Rules

- 2. This document, inclusive of any attached or referenced appendices, constitutes an agreement between the Competitors, their guests, and the Organiser. By completing and submitting this document, the Competitors and their guests agree to abide by the terms of this agreement.
- 3. In the event of any inconsistency in the terms of the Championship Rules & Regulations and any other appendix or term in some other document, the terms of this Championship Rules & Regulations take precedence.
- 4. All Competitors and/or their guests attending the Championship are additionally bound by any other rules which the Organiser may set out at some later date. The Organiser endeavours to provide information of any such modifications to the rules within reasonable time.

C. Eligibility

- 5. The deadline for submission of this entry form is 18 March 2020 at 2359h GMT +8. Late submissions will incur an administration fee of \$70. The Organiser may review each late submission on a case-by-case basis upon request.
- 6. Late submissions from overseas competitors will not be eligible for complimentary accommodation.

D. Championship Rules

- 7. The Organiser is not responsible for any loss sustained by the Competitors and/or their guests, including any personal injuries or any loss/damage to property, whether sustained by the act or omission of the Organiser or otherwise.
- 8. The Organiser reserves all rights to refuse any entries from any team, individual, or couple.
- 9. The Organiser reserves all rights to modify or cancel any event or the Championship programme without prior notice.
- 10. Any decision of any Judge in the Championship is final. No correspondence will be entertained on this matter.
- 11. All registration and entry fees submitted to the Organiser are strictly non-refundable, non-transferable to other competitors, and are not exchangeable for other events.
- 12. All Competitors must report punctually for their events. This requires that the Competitors be ready to enter the floor at the time stipulated on the Championship programme for their event. Latecomers will be disqualified from their respective event.
- 13. Competitors are not allowed to change their partners when competing in the same event.

14. The champion of Amateur Open or Professional Open events must perform an honour dance upon any request by the Organiser.

E. Event-Specific Rules

15. If a Competitor chooses to compete in multiple events of the same type (Standard or Latin), they may only do so in events which are consecutive competitive categories. For example, a Competitor registered for a “Beginner Open” Latin event may also compete in a “Novice Open” Latin event as they are consecutive competitive categories. However, a Competitor registered for a “Beginner Open” Latin event may not compete in a “Pre-Amateur” Latin event as they are two consecutive competitive categories apart.
16. The sequence of Competitors in any “Show Dance” events will be drawn by the Organiser.
17. The following age limits apply for their respective events:
 - (i) Adult Open: Both Competitors must be at least 16 years of age.
 - (ii) Youth Under 21: Both Competitors must be at least 14 and below 21 years of age.
 - (iii) Junior Under 16: Both Competitors must be at least 10 and below 16 years of age.
 - (iv) Juvenile Under 12: Both Competitors must be at least 6 and below 12 years of age.
 - (v) Masters over 35: Both Competitors must be at least 35 years of age.
 - (vi) Masters over 45: Leader must be at least 45 years of age and follower at least 35 years of age.
 - (vii) Masters over 55: Leader must be at least 55 years of age and follower at least 45 years of age.

F. Media Rules

18. The Organiser reserves the right to any Media produced during the event and will not entertain any claims concerning financial benefits through any form of media broadcast and/or publicity.
19. Anybody who wishes to record the Championship with any form of device (including photography) must purchase a recording pass from the Organiser. The Organiser reserves the right to evict and/or disqualify any Competitor or guest from the Championship if they record the Championship without a recording pass.

G. Dispute Resolution

20. The Organiser reserves the right to resolve any questions or dispute arising from these rules.
21. In the event of a dispute which cannot be resolved in the manner above, parties agree that the dispute will be referred to mediation by the Singapore Mediation Centre. In the event that parties are unable to reach consensus through mediation or there is any other dispute in relation to the conduct of the mediation, the courts of the Republic of Singapore will have exclusive jurisdiction to hear the dispute.

H. Choice of Law

22. This agreement is governed by the law of the Republic of Singapore.

I. Entire Agreement Clause

23. This document and its relevant appendices constitute the entire agreement between the parties. It supersedes any inconsistent previous drafts, agreements, arrangements, or representations between the parties, whether written or oral, relating to the subject matter.
